
What Your Giving Will Accomplish...

Text to Give You can give from your phone by texting FORWARD and the amount you want to give to 813.308.0608 (e.g. 'FORWARD50' gives \$50 dollars and 'FORWARD1000' gives \$1000 dollars).

Before You Give...

Use the following to help you make a decision about committing to **GO FORWARD**:

Pray

Pray for God to lead you in how you might sacrificially give to help Bay Life to move ahead in our calling to be used by God to reach the lost and make disciples. Also, pray for God's provision through other Lifers.

Make A Plan

With a spirit of sacrifice and thanksgiving, decide on a commitment that's pleasing to God. Then, determine how best to carry out your commitment — through monthly gifts, by reducing your budget, or some other creative giving option.

Take Action

Respond in proportion to God's blessing and provision. Paul says that gifts are "acceptable according to what a person has, not according to what he does not have" (2 Corinthians 8:12). Once you have prayerfully decided on how God wants you to respond, make the commitment!

Joyfully Fulfill Your Commitment

As you go about faithfully fulfilling what God has called you to, do so joyfully — knowing that God is pleased! Look for peace from God that surpasses all understanding as you fulfill God's plan.

Every dollar you give will help Bay Life Church accomplish God's mission for our church.

How can I give my best?

Creative ways to plan and make the most of what God has entrusted to you.

If you want to give, but just don't see how you can squeeze any more out of your budget, you are not alone. We understand how tight budgets can be.

That's why we've come up with a list of creative ways to give that you may have overlooked. Each one requires sacrifice on your part, but like King David said, "I will not offer up to the Lord anything that costs me nothing!" You may want to combine one or more of these to represent your commitment, or come up with some of your own!

- Find ways to cut your food budget.** Whether you decide to clip coupons, cut back on restaurants, drink water at restaurants, or fast a meal a week, the money you save can turn into hundreds — even thousands — of dollars over the course of a year. Make sure you deliberately set that money aside in your budget for your commitment.
- Give up your favorite treat for a year.** No one said this would be easy! But passing on that daily latte can add up.
- Commit your income tax refund check to the Lord.**
- Did you get a raise this year?** Take just that amount and set it aside for God's purposes.
- Redirect money for major purchases.** If you were going to buy a new washer, dryer, new piece of furniture or some other major purchase — hold off for a little while and use the money to take care of God's business instead.
- Adjust your vacations.** Take a more inexpensive vacation — like going somewhere closer to home . . . or cutting it to three days instead of a week. With no airfare and less hotel costs, the savings can add up quickly.
- Wait for a movie to come out for rental.** One trip to the movie theater can cost over \$40 with popcorn and candy for two people!
- Make small cuts.** Eat at home instead of getting fast food and cutting back to basic cable are small, disciplined actions that can make a big difference in your budget.
- Have a garage sale!** Go through your home or storage building and find things you can sell in a garage sale to help with your commitment.

These are just a few ideas that can help multiply your commitment. A little creative thinking and small adjustments in our lifestyle can help our congregation GO FORWARD and accomplish God's vision for us to minister to our community and beyond.
